

CVSA. International Roadcheck 2016.

The Commercial Vehicles Safety Alliance's 29th annual roadcheck will take place June 7-9, 2016.

During this 72-hour period, approximately 10,000 CVSA-certified local, state, provincial and federal inspectors in jurisdictions across North America perform truck and bus inspections. Since its inception in 1988, roadside inspections conducted during International Roadcheck have numbered more than 1.4 million.



Each year, a special emphasis is placed on a category of violations. The special emphasis for 2016 is **tire safety** (i.e., measuring the tire thread depth, checking the tire pressure, checking to make sure no items are lodged between dual tires and examining the overall condition of the tire to ensure no deep cuts or bulges exist in the sidewalls of the tire).

Food Safety Modernization Act

Sanitary Transportation of Human and Animal Food

On April 6th, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) published the final rule on Sanitary Transportation of Human and Animal Food.



Key requirements include changes to vehicles and transportation equipment, improved transportation operations, training of carrier personnel in sanitary transportation practices and the maintenance of records of written procedures, agreements and training.

The earliest compliance dates for some businesses begin one (1) year after publication.
