

Carrier and Driver Information "Safe" After FMCSA Hack CCJ

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's Medical Examiner's National Registry search tool is now partially functional after being down for more than a month following a hack of the online tool.

According to the agency, "There was no evidence of exposure of the personal information of drivers, medical examiners or motor carrier operators."

The Department of Transportation determined there had been unauthorized access to the system, and the incident remains under investigation.

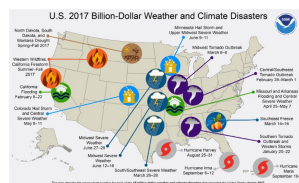
